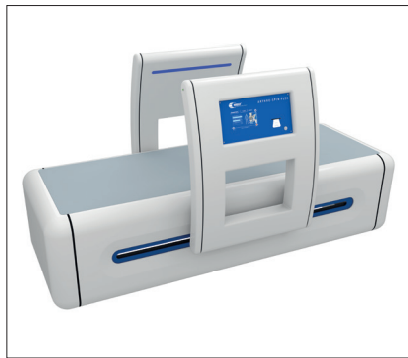


MBST magnetic resonance therapy at the Annual Meeting of Handball Doctors in Wuerzburg
